

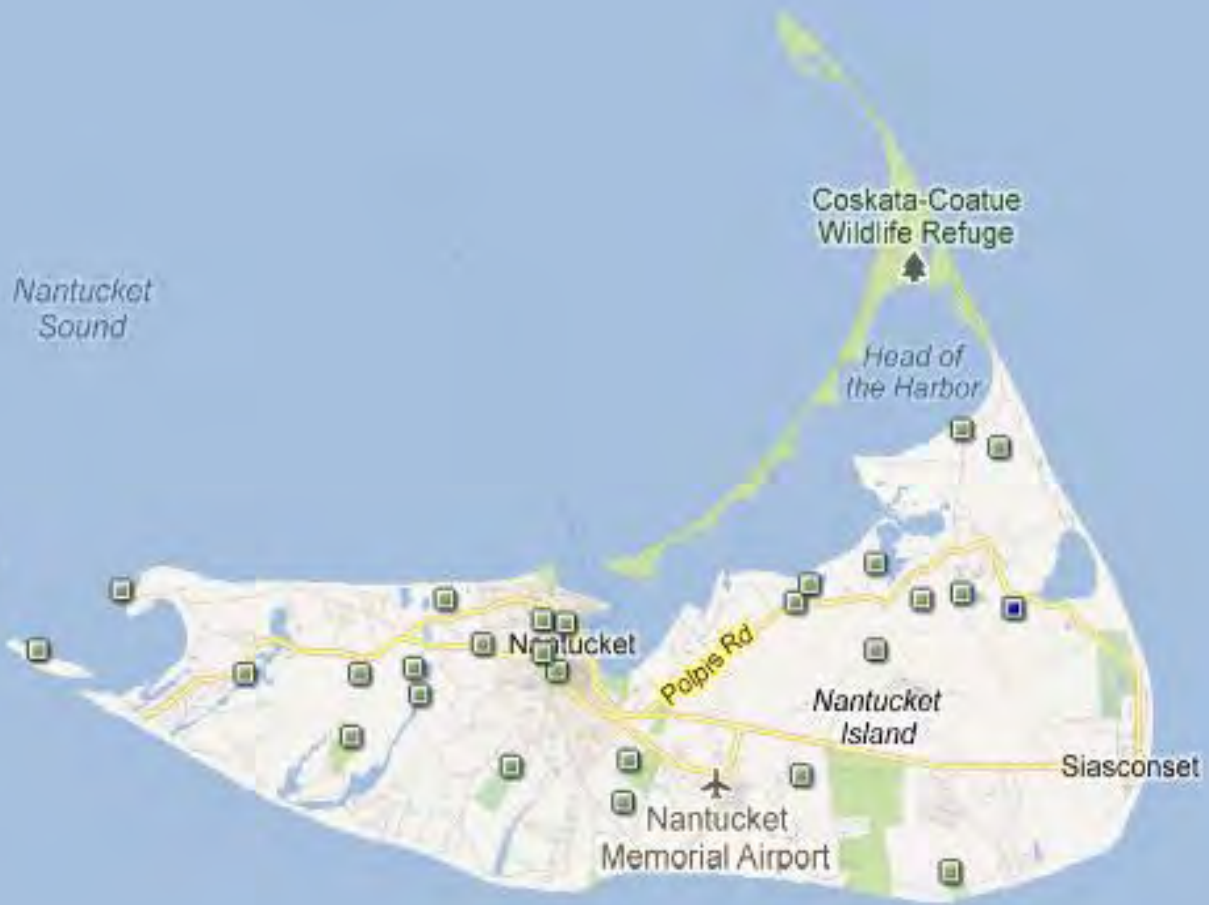

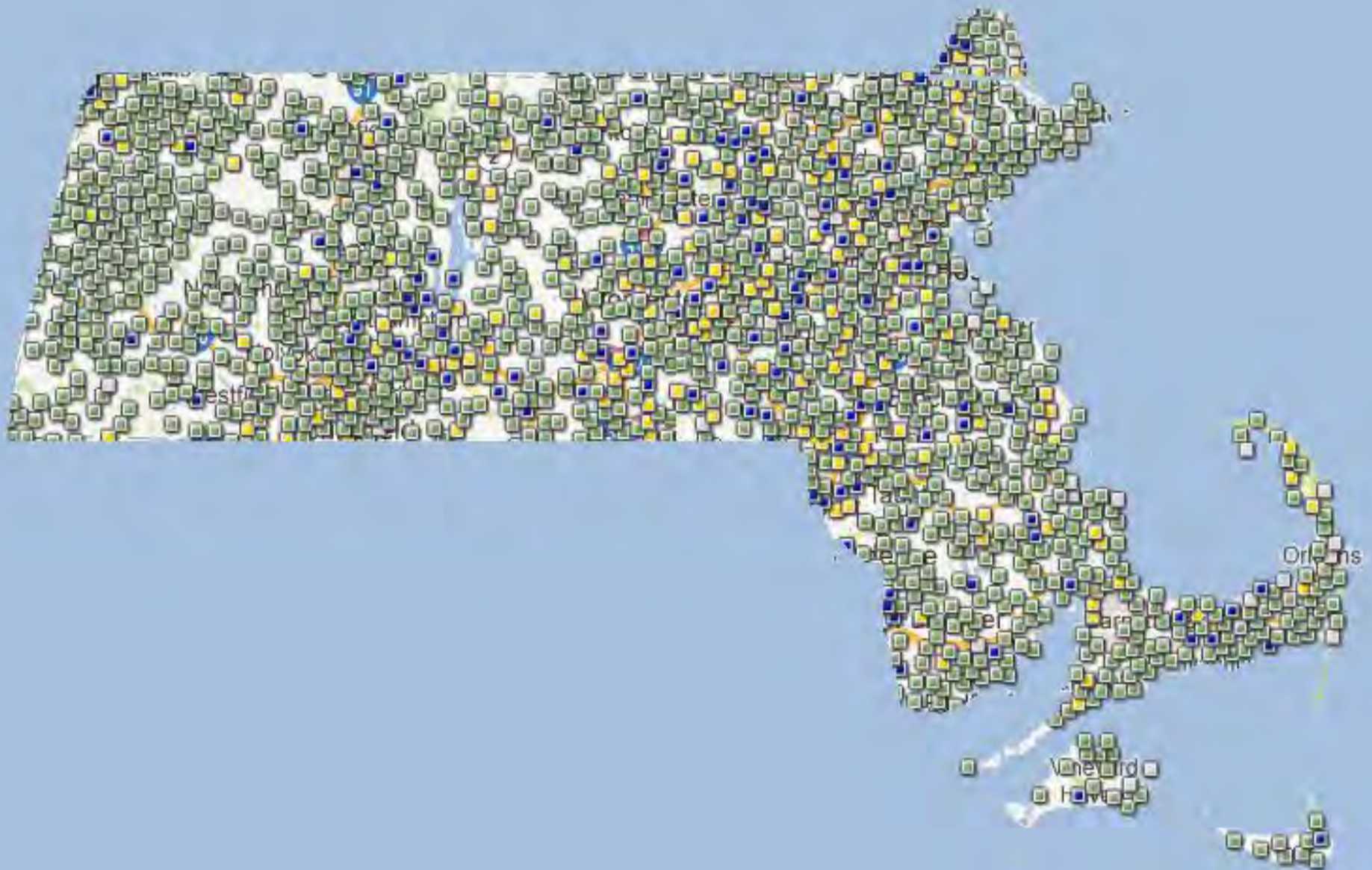

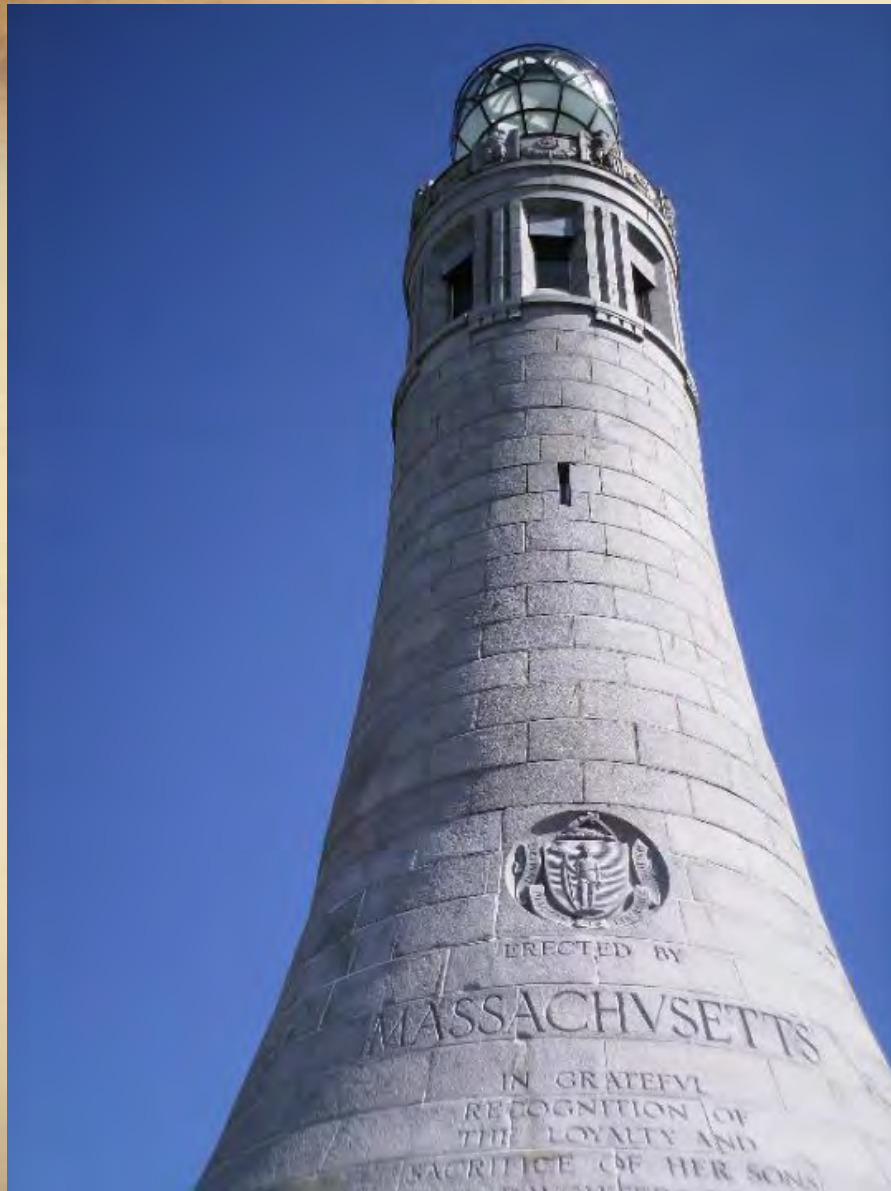

## Historic O'Neil Farm, Inc.

This 9.5 acre field has been in agricultural production since the 1700s. Forage grown here is used to feed the O'Neil Farm dairy herd. Trees in the field are red cedar. They provide shelter for native winter birds. Manure from the barn is regularly spread on the field to enrich the soil.

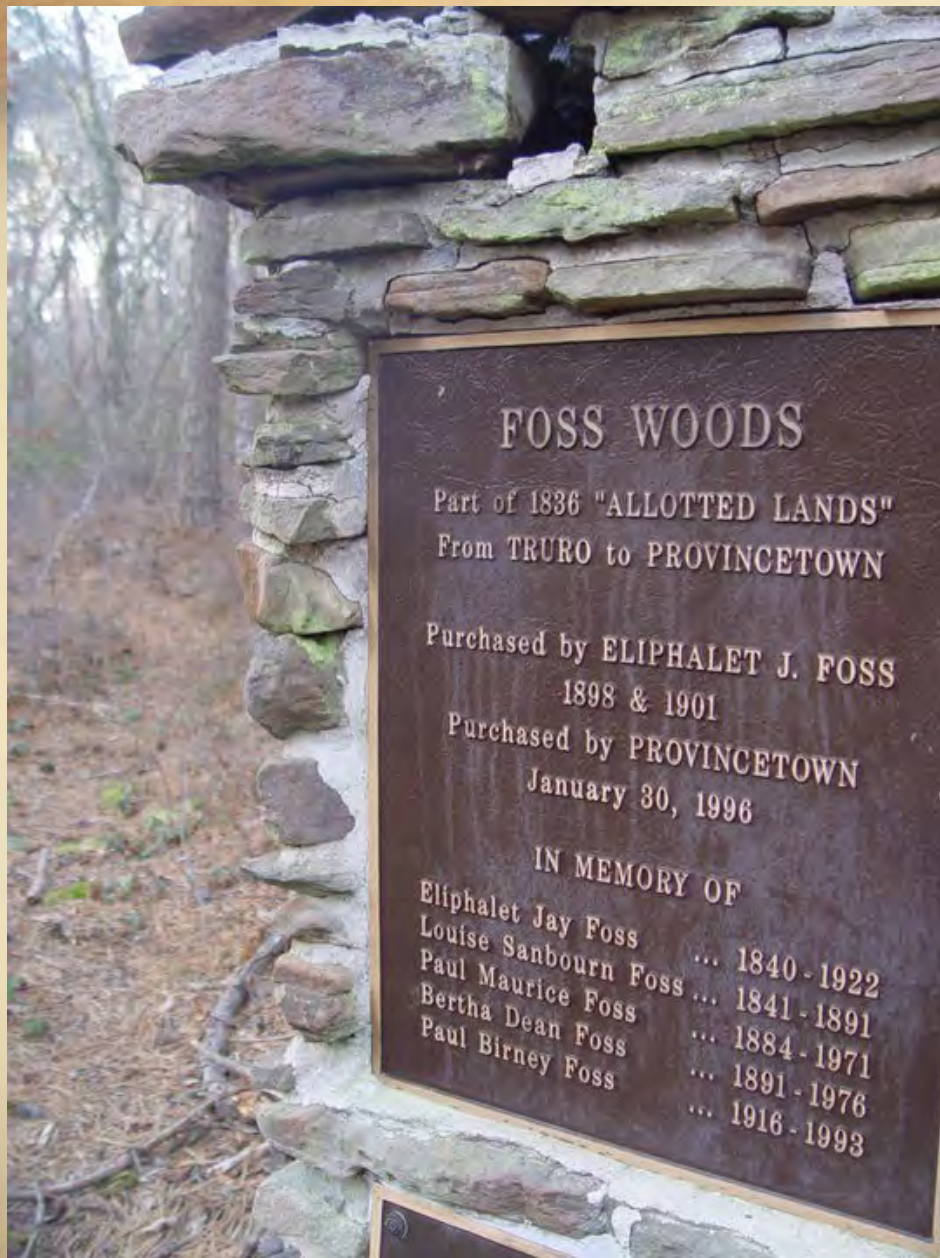












## FOSS WOODS
